PLEDGE DUTIES

1. The pledge must always wear his pledge pin.
2. The pledge must make a demerit book, decorating the covers with the colors of the fraternity, and carry it at all times.
3. The pledge must get the signatures of all present and honorary members in the pledge book.
4. The pledge must address a Brother as "mister".
5. Suits and ties must be worn to classes on Mondays and Thursdays during the pledge period.
6. The pledge must always carry change for a quarter for any brother.
7. The pledge must obtain a book of matches from each of the sororities.
8. The pledge must appropriately decorate the cover of his pledge book.

9. The pledge will obtain the signatures of three girls in each sorority.
10. The pledge must know: both names of all brothers and fellow pledges, drinkings songs & hymn, his family tree, fraternity officers, honoraries and the history of the fraternity.
11. By informal initiation the pledge will have made his paddle. Specifications are:
Three feet long, 6 inches wide $2\frac{1}{3}$ $3\frac{3}{4}$ inches thick
Colors: green and silver. Markings: name, glass year and Theta Xi Omega.
12. The pledge must write a letter to either an alumnus who is off campus or to an honorary who is off campus.

13. The pledge must carry matches for any brother.
14. The pledge must perform the duties in his hell letter.
All duties MUST be completed by informal initiation. Failure to fulfill the duties and responsibilities of a pledge and a brother will be dealt with severely at the final bid session.
